

CHICAGO DERMATOLOGICAL SOCIETY MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES AND DUES CLASSIFICATION

Updated: September 22, 2010

All new candidates applying for membership are required to pay an application fee of \$350 which is applied to the first-year dues. The fee is \$200 for graduating residents during their first two years of practice. The following categories of membership are available for new applicants:

Regular: Physicians who have completed residency training in dermatology and are licensed to

practice medicine.

Affiliate: Practicing dermatopathologists who are not eligible to be regular members; or non-dermatologist

physicians, PhDs and other scientists devoting a major portion of their time to dermatologic research and/or education in academic medical centers, teaching hospitals or industry; or physicians who are certified in dermatology by a foreign board or its licensing equivalent or who satisfy educational and professional requirements approximately equivalent to the requirements for the American Board of Dermatology or for certification in dermatology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of

Canada.

Non-Resident: Physicians who are otherwise eligible for membership but who live outside of Illinois, Indiana, Michigan,

lowa, and Wisconsin.

<u>Corresponding</u>: Distinguished dermatologists in this country or aboard as judged by the Society who otherwise are not

eligible for membership. (Exempt from paying dues.)
